Dear Madam or Sir,

Every year, the Louis François Centre of UNESCO located in Troyes (France) organises its **International Visual Arts Competition.**

In 2010, we received 3 484 works of art created by young people ranging from the age of 3 to the age of 25 from 44 countries around the world.

The theme for the year 2011 is: « Earth, Air, Water, Fire...Life ».

We would very much appreciate it if you could inform the young people in your schools and encourage them to take part either individually or as a group under the supervision of an art teacher. Enclosed is the international art competition leaflet.

The closing date for sending their creations is February 26th, 2011.

The jury which will take place on March 26th 2011 will select 500 works. Among them, 100 will be declared prizewinners.

In each category (except 18-25 years old), the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize will get a cheque of respectively 100€, 85€ and 70€. The other laureates will be awarded visual art boxes.

Note the new "young artists" category (18/25): the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize will get respectively 300, 200 and 150€. The other laureates will be awarded visual arts boxes. The global endowment of the competition will be 6000€.

The top 100 prizewinning works will be exhibited at the international art convention called « Graines d'artistes du monde entier » (in honour of Béatrice Tabah) which will take place from 24 to 28th May 2011 in Troyes.

The list of prizewinners will also be published on our internet site (http://centre.unesco.free.fr) from 6 April onwards.

We hope to receive a large number of visitors and will be happy to answer any queries you may have.
