WHERE AND WHEN

Exchange for Experience will be held between 14th and 18th November 2012. All workshops and case studies will take place at Warsaw School of Economics between 14-16th November. Trip to Cracow is planned for 17-18th November.

We would like to invite teams consisting of 3-5 members representing each organization. However, if these requirements will be unable to achieve, we are open to welcome groups of other sizes.

All student organizations willing to take part in the Conference will be required to register on special

platform and fulfill personal information about the participants. In order to know each other better, there will be minor tasks to prepare on platform, prior to arrival to Warsaw. These tasks will consider presentation of participant's country, school and themselves.
